“Swing for Singapore and the President’s Challenge 2011”



World Golfers Championship Singapore reaches out to the less fortunate by raising funds for the beneficiaries of President’s Challenge 2011.

The Fourth Edition of the World Golfers Championship (WGC) Singapore 2011 will be held in support of the President’s Challenge 2011 with the Singapore qualifying round held simultaneously at seven (7) golf clubs across the island on 28 September. A Gala Dinner and Prize Presentation to announce the qualifiers of the Singapore National Final will be held on 29 September, followed by the Singapore National Final on 5 October.

The top (5) Singapore champions emerging from the Singapore National Final will win an all-expenses paid trip to Durban, South Africa to represent Team Red Dot Singapore at this year’s WGC World Finals from 30 October till 05 November, along with representatives from over 40 countries.

The World Golfers Championship was set up to promote sports and business and part of this is to play a role in contributing to society through its social responsibility efforts. As such, this year marks a special year for WGC Singapore with this effort of raising funds for the beneficiaries through the President’s Challenge. The event aims to raise SGD\$100,000 for the President's Challenge 2011 by offering corporate golf flights and sponsorship packages.

The World Golfers Championship (WGC) is an international golf tournament for amateur golfers established in 1995 that begins each year with qualifiers around the world. WGC is designed to give all amateur golfers the thrill and prestige of a global golf championship event, with Country winners having the opportunity to represent their country at the World Finals in South Africa.

The tournament was founded by Sven Tumba and is backed by two golfing Legends: Arnold Palmer as Honorary Patron and Seve Ballesteros as Honorary Chairman of the Advisory Board and complies with the R&A amateur status rules, clause 4-2(ii).

The World Golfers Championship also support our Founder Sven Tumba's Education Fund, Sport for Education a charity in partnership with Founding Donor pharmaceutical giant, AstraZeneca, aiming to eradicate illiteracy and with added support from FIFA and UEFA.
